Dear Mayors of Alaska!

My name is Bob A. I'm a member of Debtors Anonymous, practicing our 12th Step with fellow members, by doing outreach and providing public information to those who might come into regular or semi-regular contact with suffering debtors.

We have recently developed the four attached outreach brochures, which we physically mailed to all 360 US Bankruptcy Judges and 50 US Governors' Offices last week.

We would like to do similar mailings to each of you and your cities, and to Mayors throughout the other forty-nine states, but are not funded for such an ambitious project. With a strong desire to provide outreach and information to you and your relevant city departments, I hope you will forgive this unsolicited email. We believe this information and these brochures might be of great use to both your city employees and your citizens, the latter through possible distribution by a variety of city departments.

Debtors Anonymous is a 12-Step fellowship, based on the principles and practices of Alcoholics Anonymous, and with their blessing. Unlike their 1.2 million US members, we currently have about 5,000 members in this country. We want and need to change that. We have a real solution to the problem of compulsive and otherwise out-of-control debting and spending, and we're working hard to get the word out to people who need our help and the freedom from debting that we have found and can share.

Because our membership is small, we do not have DA or BDA meetings in all of the cities, or even the states, we would like. We do, however, have a vibrant community of recovering members who meet via phone. I have both a DA and a BDA home group -- two of the attached brochures will explain the difference -- both via weekly conference calls. Between them I have become a member of an international community of people who, like me, want and have found freedom from incurring new unsecured debt. For me, it's been almost five years since the last time I borrowed ANYTHING.

I am obviously doing this service anonymously. But you would be welcome to google my phone number -- 206-327-8887 - - to verify that I am a real person living and working here in Seattle. I've been a DA member for almost five years and clean and sober in AA for more than 25 years. Because I have the time, energy, and experience, I am doing national outreach for DA and BDA. Please support my anonymity and the anonymity of any other DA member with whom you may come in contact.

Please give the above some thought and let me know if there is anything I can do to help carry the message of DA and BDA, and the potential for personal freedom from debting, into your community. There are several web links provided on each of the attached brochures, all going to our national website. Please feel free to reach out to our national headquarters directly. And please feel free to share this email and its attachments with anyone you think might be interested.

If you prefer never to hear from me again, please simply reply with "remove." I will, of course, respect your wishes.
